Up to five historic barns on the Napa side of the Carneros appellation will be featured including the Adastra Barn, Vine Village, the Stewart Ranch and the Henry Ranch. Adastra Vineyards will serve as the hub for the day's activities, including Brunch in a Barn, with a make-your-own garden fresh tomato juice station, acoustic bluegrass, and a farm/rural-focused art show.
